FULBRIGHT & LUCE SCHOLARS

National American Scholarships



FULBRIGHT & LUCE SCHOLARS PROGRAM

LUCE SCHOLARS

- 1 year internship (any field) in an Asian country
- Rigorous application process
- No guarantee of Korea
- Cannot have prior **significant** experience in Asia
- Current application hiatus

FULBRIGHT ETA

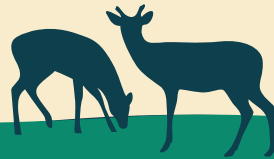
- 10 month teaching contract
- 6 week orientation (teacher training + Korean language intensive)
- Option to renew for **up to three years**
- Placement typically in rural Korea
- Homestay experience

FULBRIGHT RESEARCH

- Independent research/study
- Must have a **sponsor** in order to apply
- Any research field/subject
- Anywhere in Korea
- Less guidance from Fulbright

FULBRIGHT GRADUATE STUDIES AWARD

- New program
- Korean Intermediate Proficiency **required**
- 2 years of financial support for Masters/PhD in **Korean Studies** at a Korean university

Fall (Luce, Fulbright
Research, Study)
Spring (Fulbright ETA)

ASSEMBLE APPLICATION

Summer:

Recommendation

INTERVIEWS, SEMIFINALIST, FINALIST...

Fulbright: Semifinalist results around January,
Finalist announcements March-May
Luce: Semifinalist interviews November,
Finalist interviews January, Awards February

BLAKEMORE FREEMAN LANGUAGE GRANTS



APPLICATION DUE IN DECEMBER

For start in Fall of following AY



1 YEAR ASIAN LANGUAGE STUDY

Eligible Languages: Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Burmese, Indonesian, Khmer, Thai, and Vietnamese



OTHER NOTES

Must be at or near advanced level in language (3+ years college study or equivalent)

EPIK, CIEE, Hagwons



TEACHING IN KOREA

EPIK

- Fall application for Spring start or Spring application for Fall start
- Application and interview
 - TESOL/TEOFL certification **not sponsored**
- Salary range from 1.8-2.5 million **starting** based on experience and free housing
- 52 week contract (renewable)

CIEE

- 2 semester contract at a **Hagwon** (private school)
 - Program Fee** includes cost of TESOL/TEOFL certification, insurance
- Salary range from 2.1-2.4 million and free housing

HAGWON

- Similar salary, housing may not be covered
 - Generally require TESOL/TEOFL certification
 - Find jobs through recruiters or personal connections

KOREAN LANGUAGE YEAR

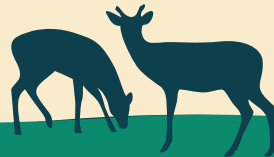
Must achieve Topik 3

MONTHLY STIPEND

1,000,000 won/month

FLIGHTS + QUARANTINE

Arrival + departure



APPLICATION PROCESS

-15 minutes with the Korean embassy

about 1 week after application submission

INTERVIEW

-NIIED approves you
-application is sent to chosen universities
-may have interviews with the universities
-final university selection

Announcement: around: May

2ND SELECTION ROUND

EMBASSY/UNIVERSITY TRACK

-Apply through local language education center

Announcement: mid Feb
Submission: mid March

-General application
-Personal statement + 3 essays
-Academic & citizenship records
-Any additional materials

1ST SELECTION ROUND

-embassy nominates you & sends your application to NIIED

Announcement: around April

FINAL SELECTION ROUND

-Korean language year placement

Announcement: around June

Arrival: around August
